- Demonstrated ability to work with large and diverse teams and the ability to effectively provide guidance, direction, and supervision in all areas of contracted effort such as program management, systems engineering, major system acquisitions, and financial management.
- Experience interacting and interfacing with management and team members for the purposes of understanding and responding to requirements and needs.
