- Expert knowledge of Marine Corps Equipment Readiness reporting in both deployed and garrison maintenance operations.
- Functional knowledge or hands-on experience with Oracle eBusiness suites R11 or R12 modules.
- End user experience with USMC automated Information systems (AIS) (Marine Corps Integrated Maintenance Management (MIMMS) and Personal Computer Marine Corps Integrated Maintenance Management System (PCMIMMS)).
- Ability to conduct qualitative and quantitative analysis on Marine Corps logistics chain management AIS processes.
- Additional credentials: Information Technical Infrastructure Library (ITIL v3) certification, Oracle eBusiness suite certifications (R11 or R12), Experience with the United States Marine Corps logistics operational architecture, business process improvement methodologies.
- Practical work experience with Global Combat Support Systems – Marine Corps/Logistics Chain Management Increment 1.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office Suite.
